





FrankfurtRheinMain Knowledge Region "Longitude" Key Questions

- Most relevant: how to create meaning? "Sinnergie" (C.Savage)
- How to integrate relevant stakeholder and their controversial interests in the process?
- How to link the ICR process to everyday's business of the parties involved?
- How to put the ICR into action i. e. how to develop projects out of the ICR's conclusions?

Concluding Remarks

Regional and corporate IC Management follow the same logic of getting human, structural and relational potential in productive balance

A "Knowledge Region" has to integrate autonomous stakeholders of controversial interests that still are interrelated

ICR has potential to assist "management by meaning" (Sinnergie) to bridge "partial logic" and support sustainability and foresight.

This enabling, incubating, facilitating process has to consciously live with uncertainty. That is part of the "longitude" dimension of a Knowledge Region
